# Photo contest. Terms and conditions.

### PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST

Fill in the compulsory fields (the name of the author of the photo(s), e-mail address and the location where the photo(s) were taken)

- Upload 1-3 photos matching the theme of the contest
- Choose the categories in which you would like to compete
- If you wish to submit photos in different categories, please fill the form and upload the photo(s) separately for each category
- The widest side of the uploaded photo has to be at least 1,600 pixels, the file should be between 3-15 MB.

## THE AUTHOR'S RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- The contest participants will be responsible for submitting the correct information about themselves and the photo(s) and confirm that they are the authors of the submitted photo(s).
- The participant needs to ensure that the uploading of the photo(s) was successful (the website will display a confirming message after a successful upload).
- In the case when there are people on the uploaded photos, the author needs to ensure that they have the consent to submit and publish the photo from everybody in the photo.
- All submitted photos will be reviewed by the organiser of the contest before being published. Approved photos which are in accordance with the theme and technical requirements will be published in the gallery within 7 workdays from uploading at the latest.
- By submitting photos to the competition, the photographers agree to a creative commons, attribution, non-commercial share-alike license (BY-NC-SA). Competition organisers (incl. the Estonian Peat Association and the International Peatland Society) will use winning photos for event materials and exhibition at the Congress. The photographers shall not use the photos for commercial purposes.

#### THE ORGANISER'S RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- The organisers will have the right not to publish photos submitted to the contest if they do not match the task description or the theme of the contest, the photo's technical quality does not enable publishing, there is reasonable doubt about the copyright of the submitted photos, the same photo has been submitted to the contest more than once etc.
- If the uploaded photo(s) have not been published within 7 workdays after submission at the latest, the author has the right to send an enquiry to the organisers of the contest at <a href="mailto:info@ipc2020.com">info@ipc2020.com</a>.
- The organisers are obligated to refer to the author of the photo when using a photo they submitted to the contest.
- The organisers cannot allow the photos to be used by any third parties.
- Members of the organizing committees of the IPC2020 and the Photo contest may participate the contest, but are not eligible to win any awards.

#### SELECTION OF WINNERS

The submitted photos will be ranked in three technical categories – camera, smart phone and drone photos; and in two age groups: adults and children up to 13 years old (incl.).

The winners will be determined by a panel made up of representatives from National Geographic and the congress organisers. Everybody can participate in the vote for the audience award by giving a like on Facebook to the photo they like the most. Voting is open throughout the contest. In addition, the contest's sponsors will select their favourites.

The winners of the contest will be announced in the second half of May 2020. The winners will be announced on the congress homepage and the organisers will contact the winners within 7 days after the winners are announced. WHAT'S THE PRIZE?

The prize of the winner of the photo contest will be the Fujifilm hybrid camera X-T30 that was contributed by Fujifilm. The organiser and sponsors of the contest will also provide various prizes for the winners of all technical categories, age groups and special categories.
